1.0 QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1.1 *Question:*

Please explain what cash and contingency allowances are for?

Answer:

Cash allowance is for pre-determined services, products, or for other authorized expenses specified. Contingency allowance is for unforeseen conditions that the City is unaware of, at the time of tender.

1.2 *Question:*

Our understanding is that cost of work by Enbridge is not part of the tender and General Contractor will provide coordination with Enbridge only. Is the contractor responsible for the cost? (City takes care of this cost) Or is it just the coordination?

Answer:

Enbridge service upgrade is to be covered by cash allowance. Contractor to contact Enbridge within 5 business days of receiving a purchase order and coordinate all associated work.

1.3 *Question:*

In regards to the temporary shoring on drawing S4.01, "temporary shoring by others", is this the responsibility of the contractor? Should we carry a cost for shoring?

Answer:

Temporary shoring is the responsibility of the contractor and any cost associated to it has to be included in the bid price.
