<p>Description of Procurement:</p>	<p>The City of Toronto invites bids for the Installation of New Gas Stand-by Generator at Fire Hall 121 located at 10 William Carson Crescent, Toronto, in accordance with the drawings and specifications, including any addenda issued during the time of Tender Call. Note the drawings, specifications, general conditions, and other documents contained within the Tender Package shall be read in conjunction with each other. Discrepancies between documents must be identified during the bidding process and brought to the City's attention for clarification/resolution.</p> <p>For reference purposes, this work shall include, but not necessarily be limited to the short summary below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Contractor shall plan, schedule, and coordinate construction activities to minimise disruption to the building occupants and public. In particular the delivery of all products and materials. 2. Provide a detailed schedule in MS Project format, in accordance with the City of Toronto – CCDC Supplementary Conditions, indicating staged construction as noted in the drawings and specifications, and completion within the period specified. The schedule must be approved by the City and Toronto Fire Services prior to commencement of work. Update schedule as required or requested by the City Project Manager to ensure accuracy of project deliverables. 3. Planning, scheduling, coordination and supervision of all sub-trades and work during the implementation of the scope of work. Ensure that sub-trades are coordinated in a manner to cause the least amount of disruption and shortest project duration. 4. Provide a construction sequencing and staging plan to the Consultant and City Project Manager indicating site access, safety barriers, material staging area, work areas, phasing of work and disposal bin location. This plan must be approved by the City and Toronto Fire Services prior to any mobilization on site. 5. Provide hoarding and temporary signage to safely direct building occupants and public away from the Construction Zone. Exterior hoarding shall be complete with exit doors.

	<p>6. Protection of existing facility, and adjacent facilities, finishes, etc. during project. Any damages caused by the Contractor to existing facilities will be the Contractor's responsibility to rectify.</p> <p>7. The Contractor shall conduct and provide a copy of the required pre-construction photographic survey of the entire area of construction, delivery and access points, presented in a report format to the City Project Manager prior to the start of construction.</p> <p>8. Patching and making good of existing finishes to match existing affected by the new work as indicated in the attached Construction Documents and any areas damaged by trades during the work.</p> <p>9. New construction as indicated in attached Construction Documents, including but not limited to the above.</p> <p>The date of Substantial Performance for construction shall be 28 weeks from the date of the purchase order, and the Deemed Completion date shall be 29 weeks from the date of the purchase order.</p> <p><u>Note: For complete Scope of Work details refer to details in Tender document viewing copy.</u></p> <p>Mandatory 1. Project Experience / Comparable Projects</p> <p>The Bidder must provide reference projects for the purpose of confirming the Bidder's experience and track record of success as per Section 2, Item 8.2 A. Failure to provide verifiable experience will result in the bid being declared non-compliant.</p>
