1. REVISED CLOSING DATE

The closing date has been extended from March 1, 2019 to March 8, 2019.

2. REVISION**i. Contract Document**

The paragraph from Section 2 item 8.2.A.1 Experience and Qualifications Form is deleted in its entirety

and is replaced with:

In the past ten (10) years, the Bidder must have successfully completed, as the General Contractor as defined by the Construction Act or Construction Lien Act, three (3) bridge projects with an aggregate value of \$12,000,000.00, or four (4) bridge projects with an aggregate value of \$14,000,000.00, each with a value in excess of \$3,000,000.00 (all figures excluding HST). Each project must have involved bridge rehabilitation / improvement work on an arterial roadway in a major municipality.

3. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q1: Can the mandatory experience timeline be changed from 5 years to 10 years? Many of our projects over the last 5 years have been as subcontractors on large projects.

A1: The mandatory experience requirements have been updated.

Q2: To ensure that the City receives a greater number of competitive bids from qualified bridge contractors, may we kindly request that the City allow project experience up to a 10 year period instead of the 5 year period currently noted under the mandatory requirements section for the noted tender? Please advise.

A2: The mandatory experience requirements have been updated.

Q3: Due to the size of the tender, coming long weekend and short month of February we are asking 3-week extension of time.

A3: A one week extension has been provided.

Q4: We are requesting and extension of this project.

A4: A one week extension has been provided.

Q5: Please clarify where the temporary pavement markings, both paint and tape are paid.

A5: Per Section 4A, Supplementary Specification 23 - Construction Specification for Pavement Marking:

"All costs associated with temporary pavement marking and short term pavement marking shall include the permanent removal of the markings and any and all interim removals and replacements due to the failure of pieces to remain in according to specifications. Payment shall be considered incidental to the traffic control item. No separate payment shall be made."
