I. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

- Q1. The drawings provided on the CD do not show any existing test stations or vaults. Are there any CP specific drawings provided by the CP vendor? In order to provide competitive pricing, the drawings will greatly help.
- A1. Test stations shall be installed as per the specifications. There are no separate drawings provided by the City.
- Q2. Can we have any of the past CP survey reports? The reports will tremendously help in providing competitive pricing.
- A2. No further information shall be provided by the City.
- Q3. Can we have construction CP As-builts or commissioning reports?
- A3. No further information shall be provided by the City.
- Q4. Would the city be interested in having a separate proposal on pre testing as the results of pre survey determines the costs of CP installation and possibly post survey. Most companies can provide better pricing for all of the installation work and post survey work if they can do the presurvey on its own as a separate project.
- A4. No, the City does not consider having a separate proposal on pre testing.
- Q5. Is there a possibility of submission deadline? We are still waiting to get pricing back from subcontractors.
- A5. No extension to the closing date is considered by the City at this time.

- Q6. We own specialized equipment that can confirm GPS coordinates and readings at the same location for pre/post survey without any guess work. Did you want us to provide brochures on that separately?
- A6. Bidder is required to submit a complete Tender document including any additional information. However, additional information may not be evaluated by the City.
