٥		The requested location is not in front of a building entrance, exit, name or number, fire hose connection or display window?
٥		The requested location is in front of a display window and you have obtained the written statement(s) of the building owner <b>and</b> the occupant indicating that there are no objections to your proposed use of the requested location?
٥		No other business within 25 metres of your requested location sells products similar to those which you propose to sell.
٥		No other vending locations are currently located within a 25 metre radius of your proposed location.
٥		Is the requested location is in a Business Improvement Area (BIA)?
٥		The requested location is in a BIA and you have obtained written consent from the BIA's Board of Directors to your proposed use of the requested location.
٥		There is a minimum width of 3.66 metres of clear sidewalk or paved and passable boulevard space adjacent to the requested location.

٥		The portable display unit and seat will fit within 2.32 square metres and are easily removed by one person.

		The application location is located on one of the Schedules included in the vending package.
٥		The application location is more than 25 metres (82 feet) of any business selling similar products. Note food is food, jewelry is jewelry, clothing is clothing, etc.
<u> </u>		The application location is more than 25 metres (82 feet) of any entrance or exit to a place of worship.
		The vending location includes standing space and safety zone from curb (if at curbside. Both are a minimum of .60 metres (2 feet).
٥		The entire vending location, including standing area seat and waste receptacle, fits in 2.32 square metres (24 square feet). (e.g.: 0.91 metres ( 3 feet) by 2.44 metres (8 feet) or any combination equaling 2.32 square metres).
۵		The vending location, including standing and safety zone, once set up on City Street Allowance* provides a minimum of 3.66 metres (12 feet) of clear paved and passable sidewalk space.
		* Street lines are available from the Survey Division at 277 Victoria Street, 10 <sup>th</sup> floor.
